Enrollment & Payment Policy

You are enrolled through the end of our school year - June 27, 2020. You may withdraw at any time with a minimum of one week's notice given to the office.

There are five billing cycles in our school year session. The first billing cycle runs 9/5/19-10/30/19 & we are closed on 10/31/19. There will be 8 classes offered during each billing cycle or prorated if less than 8 classes. Tuition is due one week prior to the commencement of each 8 week billing cycle.

Tuition Due Dates:

- at time of registration,
- Oct 25th, 2nd billing cycle
- Jan. 3rd, 3rd billing cycle
- Feb 28th, 4th billing cycle
- April 24th & final billing cycle

Tuition is PAST DUE 7 days after the tuition due date and a late fee of \$15 will be applied to your account. If your credit card declines, your account will incur a \$10 credit card rejection fee.
