Enrollment & Payment Policy

You are enrolled through the end of our school year - June 23, 2018. You may withdraw at any time with a minimum one week or greater notice given to the office.

Tuition is calculated to include all Gymnastics East closures as listed on the class schedule & our website.

Tuition Due Dates:

at time of registration,

Oct. 23rd, Jan. 2nd, Feb 26th April 23rd

Although the number of class days per month may vary, your tuition has been calculated to average out over the course of the school year.

Tuition is PAST DUE **7** days after the tuition due date and a late fee of \$15 will be applied to your account.
